There are food, handicrafts, beauty and hygiene products and cleaning products, which are part of a chain / **alliance between consumers and small producers** in Africa, Asia, Latin America and of Europe, and Portugal.

The movement pays **special attention** to exports from developing countries to developed countries, such as handicrafts and agricultural products. In a nutshell, it is trade where the **producer receives fair remuneration** for his work.

Some countries have **consumers who are concerned** about sustainability and who choose to buy products sold through fair trade. This **ethical option** has allowed the small producers of tropical countries to live in a dignified way when making the option for agroecology, like organic agriculture.

Fair trade has **advantages over the conventional**: the purchase of foods manufactured **without chemical additives** allows to finance the Education or Health of poor producing communities in Africa, Asia and Latin America.
